



## Design Your Own Yorkshire Wildlife Tour

There is amazing diversity in East and North Yorkshire. From the rolling chalk hills full of wild flower grasslands in the Yorkshire Wolds, towering cliffs of Flamborough Headland, the massive Humber Estuary and the heather moorland and forests of the North York Moors National Park (NYMNP).

Yorkshire Coast Nature can design a be-spoke tour to suit you as an individual, your small group of friends or an organised group you belong to. Recent one day trips have included a day on the trail of the Goshawk and a day seeking out rare butterflies in the NYMNP. We also do group holidays. Recent examples include a 3-5 day birdwatching trip for The Finch Birdwatching Group from Fife in Scotland and a Wildlife of the NYMNP tour we ran for Market Harborough Naturalists Society. Included in the trips are: Expert wildlife guides from YCN, self-catering or full board accommodation, all transport on the tour and the use of high quality binoculars and a telescope.
